



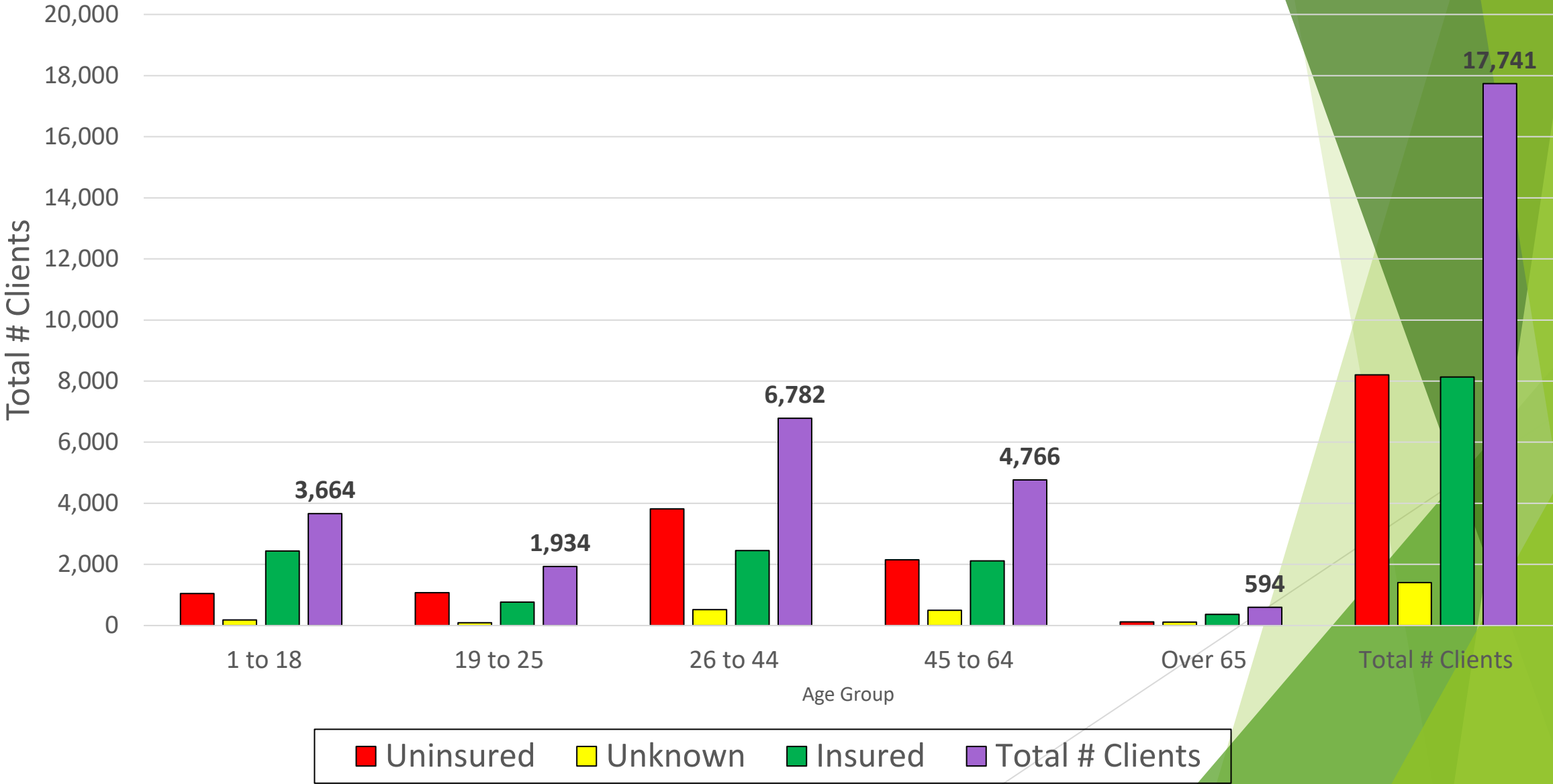

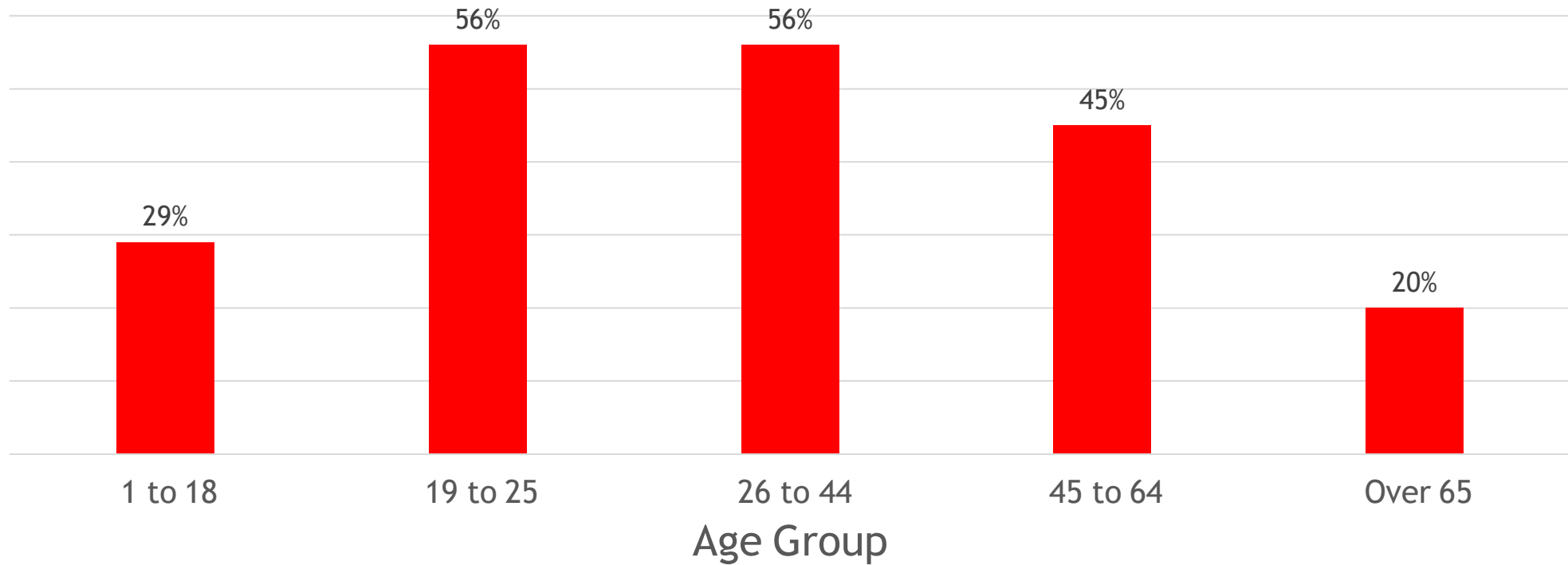

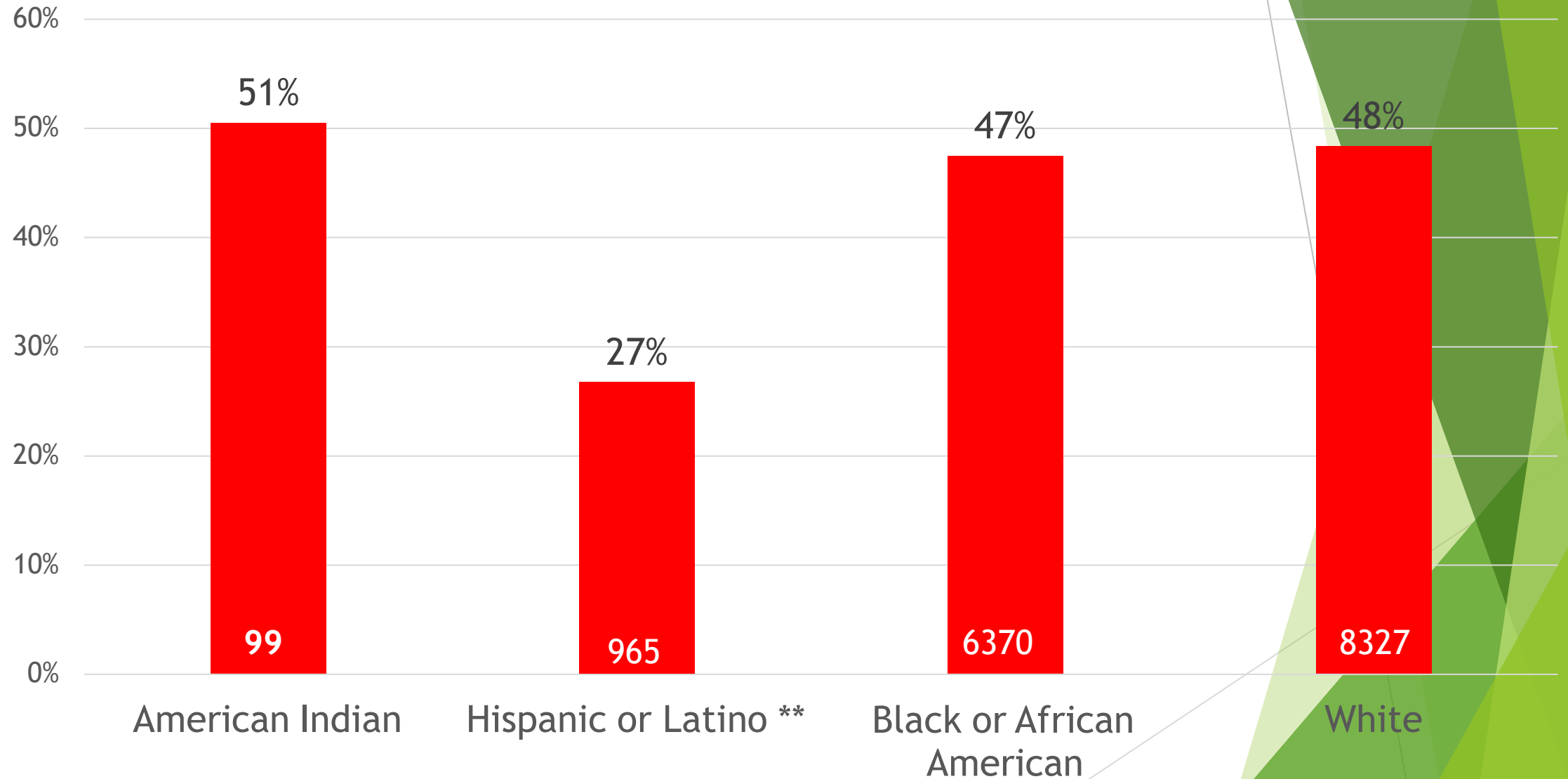
## Insurance Status by Age Group



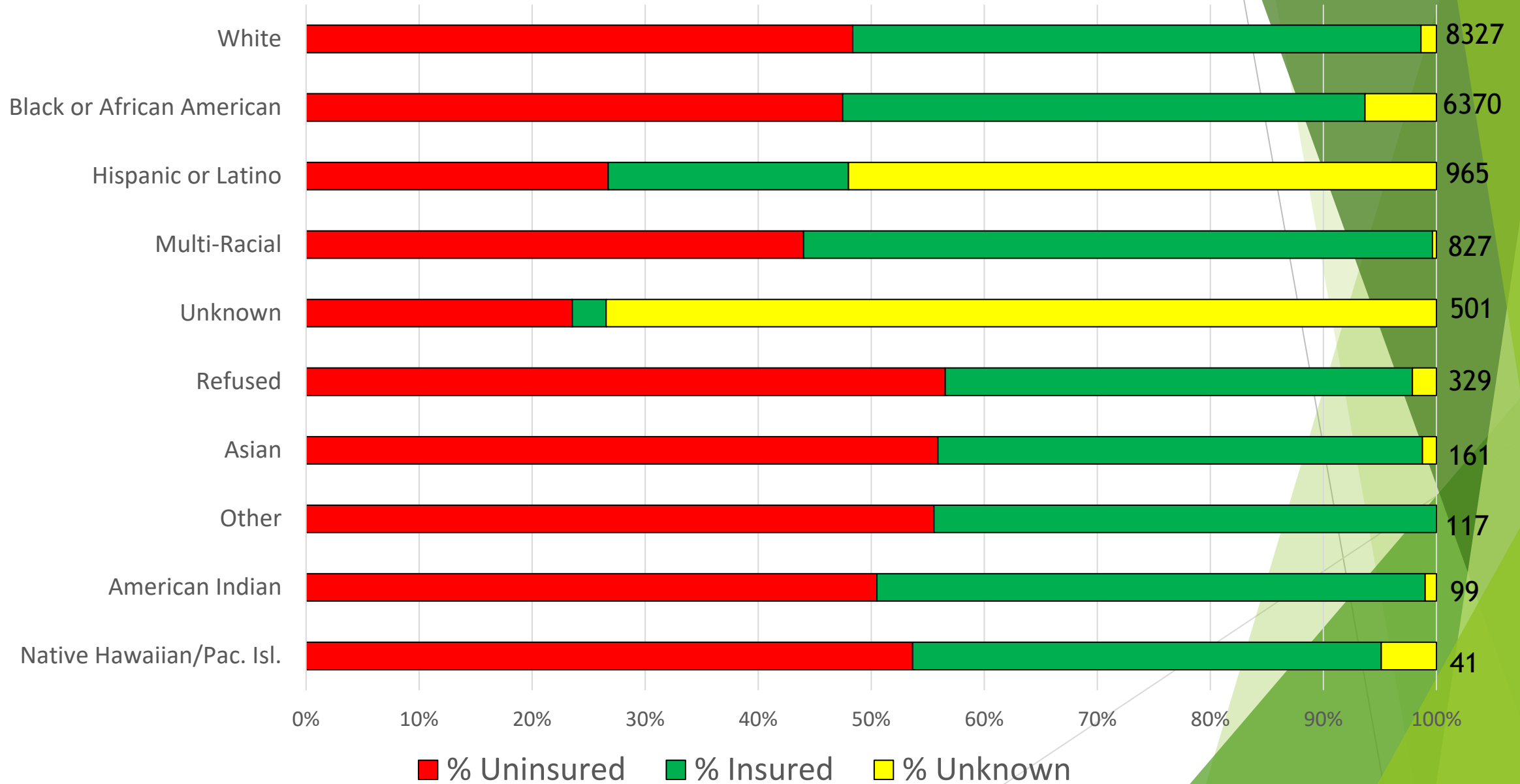

# Insurance Status by Race (Percentages %)



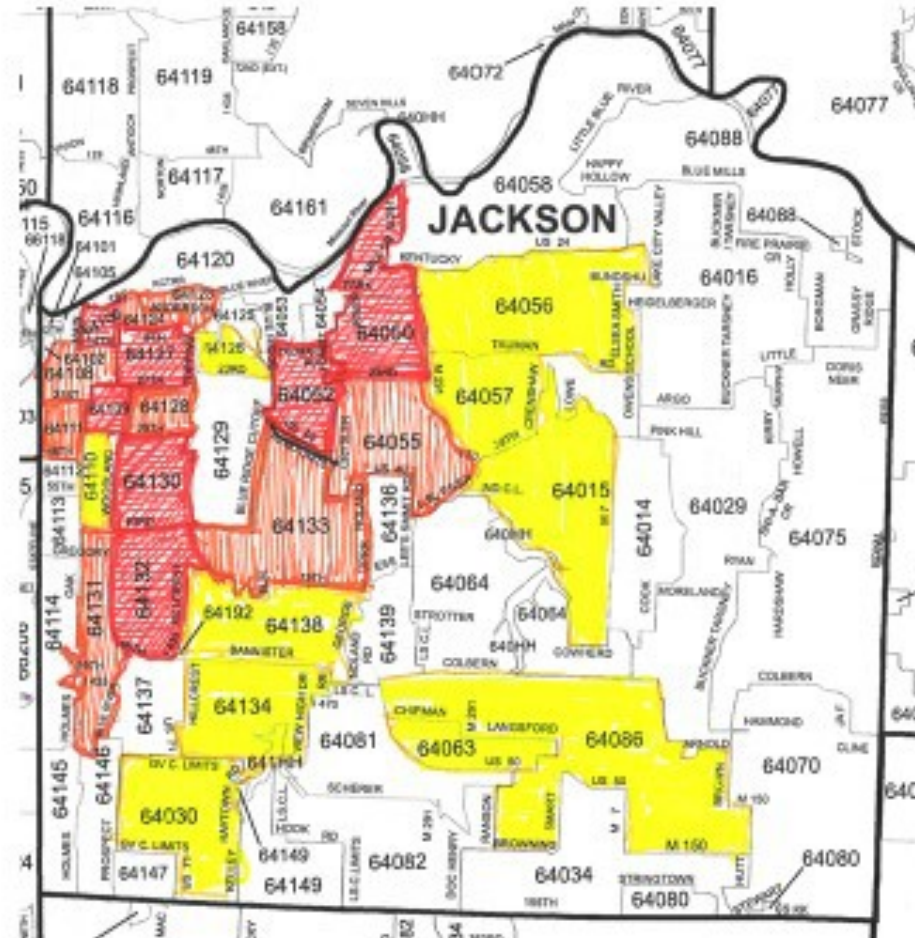

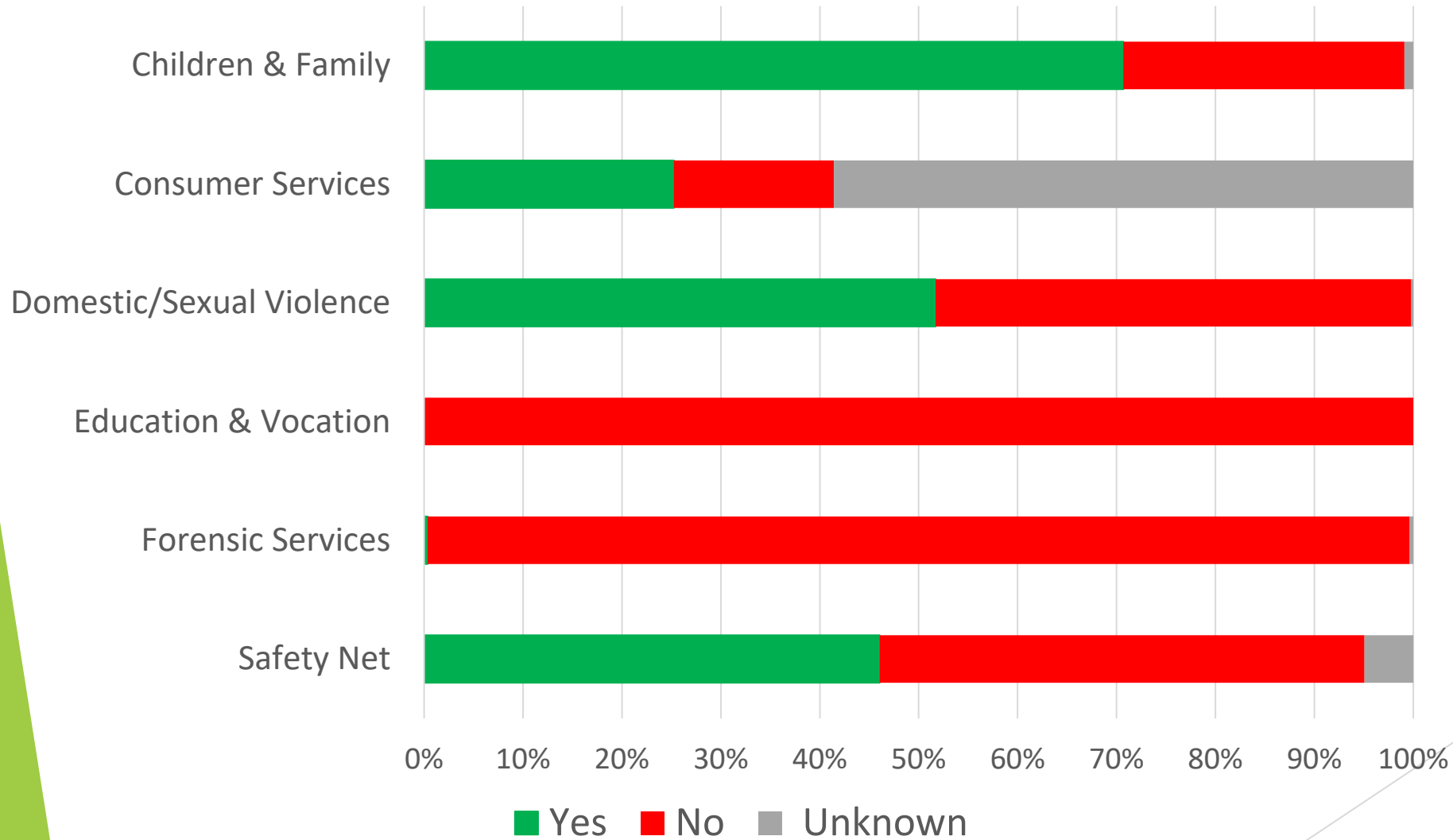

# Data Observations

- ▶ Missing data limit assumptions
  - ▶ Insurance status of Hispanics
- ▶ Out of County zip codes
  - ▶ Low percentage
  - ▶ Legal, accountability, Payment issues
  - ▶ Past: required separate analyses, audit, disallowed costs
- ▶ Training, time, availability, internal and external error checking
- ▶ Forensic
  - ▶ Disproportionate
- ▶ Spending: 2018-2020 Transitional
  - ▶ Jail funding
  - ▶ Case management to 3 tiers
  - ▶ Unit costs set
  - ▶ Incentives
  - ▶ Compare 2017 to 2021
