

Q: In past years, we have had to submit multiple Expenditure Plan spreadsheets with partial and full units. We want to double check that we only submit one Expenditure Plan this year with total units, correct?

A: For each service in the drop-down, there is an option to select fully funded or partially funded — so you are technically submitting one plan but both partially and fully funded services will be reflected.

Q: May an agency apply for Psycho-Educational group service in order to provide support and education around traumatic events in neighborhoods such as a homicide or other trauma? Individuals needing further support would be referred to services. Would each participant need to become an agency “client” with documentation beyond sign-in sheets? Or would this be under the “other” category?

A: An individual would not need to be a formal client of the agency in order to participate in psycho educational group in the community. For documentation, we would need to have a participant sign in with a means of verifying Jackson County residence. Further documentation requirements are in the service unit definition guide on our website. Also please make sure that you’ve looked carefully at the service unit definition for psycho educational group. From your description I’m not clear if these would be in response to an incident in the community and/or a more routine offering to address incidents either that have occurred or in anticipation of those that might. Either way, I would expect to see some formality as to the structure in terms of topic/content of the groups.
